I love to pray with the Lenten daily devotional card each morning. When I read this particular prayer, it was one of those mornings that I had to drag myself to move. Outside was dark and cloudy. My body was as heavy as a soaked blanket. When I was tempted to start the day rather grumpy and take it for granted, the prayer awakened me. 'God made this new day for me and bless my just-barely-hanging-on day. Am I not grateful for the gift?!'

God is with us on our best, joyous, enlivened, and colorful days. And God is with us on our so-so days, or even bottom-low days when we want to blame everything on God and cannot comprehend if God really loves us and cares about us. The forty-day journey of Lent is often described as a wilderness journey. Figuratively, we enter into the spiritual wilderness to meditate on Jesus's life and death, especially his journey toward Jerusalem. At the same time, many people are living in desert-like places and circumstances - people live under poverty, oppression, war and violence, whose homes and communities are destroyed by natural disasters, people struggling to get clean water, safe shelters, proper education or secure job to meet the needs of the family, and those who live in fear and worry because of their health or economic conditions, backgrounds, identities, legal status ...

Where have you experienced wilderness this Lent, and how have you found God's grace and blessing in those barren and parched places, friends? In our continuing Lenten journey, may we find God's abiding presence in every place in between. May we align our hearts and lives with the heart of God, merciful and gracious beyond our measures. May we stop, turn around, and see God's face in the frightened, neglected, and ostracized neighbors around us.


